ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This Administrative Order is being issued in response to the recent outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Nevada. On March 15, 2020, Governor Stephen Sisolak declared a state of emergency and closed all public, private and charter schools K-12 until April 6, 2020 to prevent the spread of the virus. After review of the restrictions and confinements of the Juvenile Court and Juvenile Detention Center and for the protection of the community;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that visitation of juveniles committed at the Juvenile Detention Center is suspended for 30 days;

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that juveniles shall appear by teleconference for court hearings and appointments with their attorneys and any other party essential to their court case.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Chief Juvenile Probation Officer or her designee have the authorization to release a juvenile from custody at the Juvenile Detention Center for their own health and welfare or the health and welfare of others in the facility. When such releases occur, the Chief Juvenile Probation Officer or her designee is required to notify all parties in the case, parents, or designated guardians. Releases can include the use of Global Positioning System (GPS), house arrest/home detention, own recognizance to parent, guardian or treatment facility or any other appropriate placement.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Order will continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the First Judicial District Court Clerk's Office disseminate copies of the order to Carson City City's Manager, Carson City District Attorney, Nevada State Public Defender, Division of Child and Family Services and Court Appointed Special Advocates.
